Dillos at Divisionals and Invitationals

What are the Divisional and Invitational Swim Meets?

Our Aquadillos competitive swim season ends with two exciting events: the Divisional Meet on July 17th and the Invitational Meet on July 18th. This year the Aquadillos are in Division II along with the Brushy Creek Marlins and the Forest North Stingrays.

Our Divisional Meet will be hosted by Brushy Creek and all three teams will compete for the Division II meet trophy. Trophies will also be awarded to the first, second and third place boys and girls who score the highest number of points in individual events. We want all of our Aquadillo swimmers to participate especially since team points are awarded out to the eighth place!

The Invitational Meet includes swimmers from all 13 North West Swim Circuit (NWSC) teams. These swimmers are "invited" to compete at the University of Texas Swim Center if they swam fast enough to qualify during the season. We post the new Aquadillos Invitational qualifiers each week on the Williams Drive bulletin board. Gold, silver and bronze medals are awarded to the top three places in each event. Participation ribbons are awarded to all other swimmers. Every year the perpetual NWSC Invitational Meet Trophy is awarded to the top team in each division. Finally, the Invitational Meet recognizes the fastest swimmers in the All Circuit Team which is composed of the three boys and girls in each age group who score the highest number of points in individual events. Trophies are awarded to the first place swimmers and plaques to the second and third place swimmers.

The NWSC designs a new T-Shirt each year to commemorate these two events. The 2010 shirt is dark blue with a swimmer diving into the water. The back of the T-shirt shows all of the teams in the NWSC. These shirts are available for purchase but act quickly because the **deadline is Saturday, 26 June!** A sample photo is seen below!
